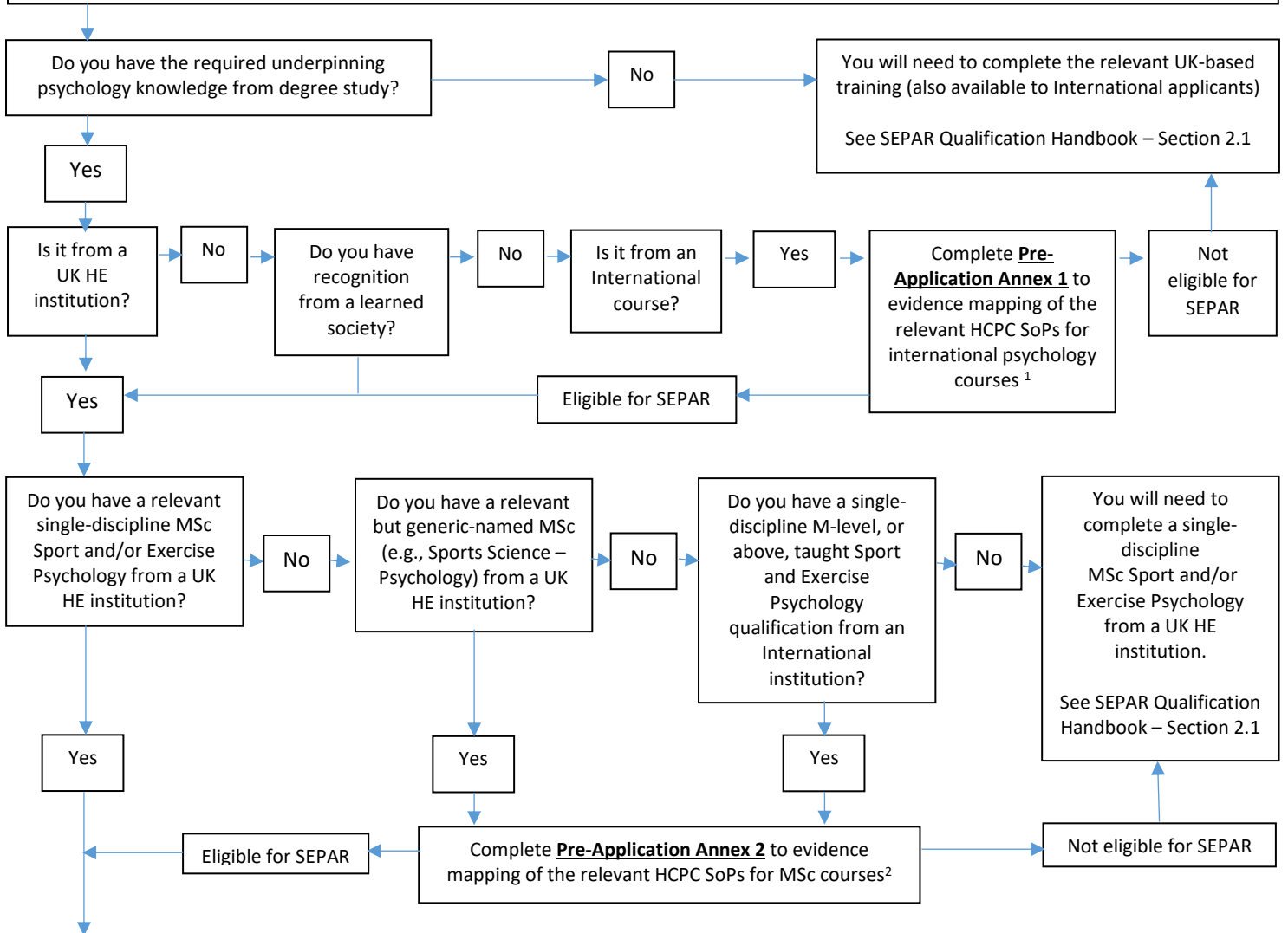


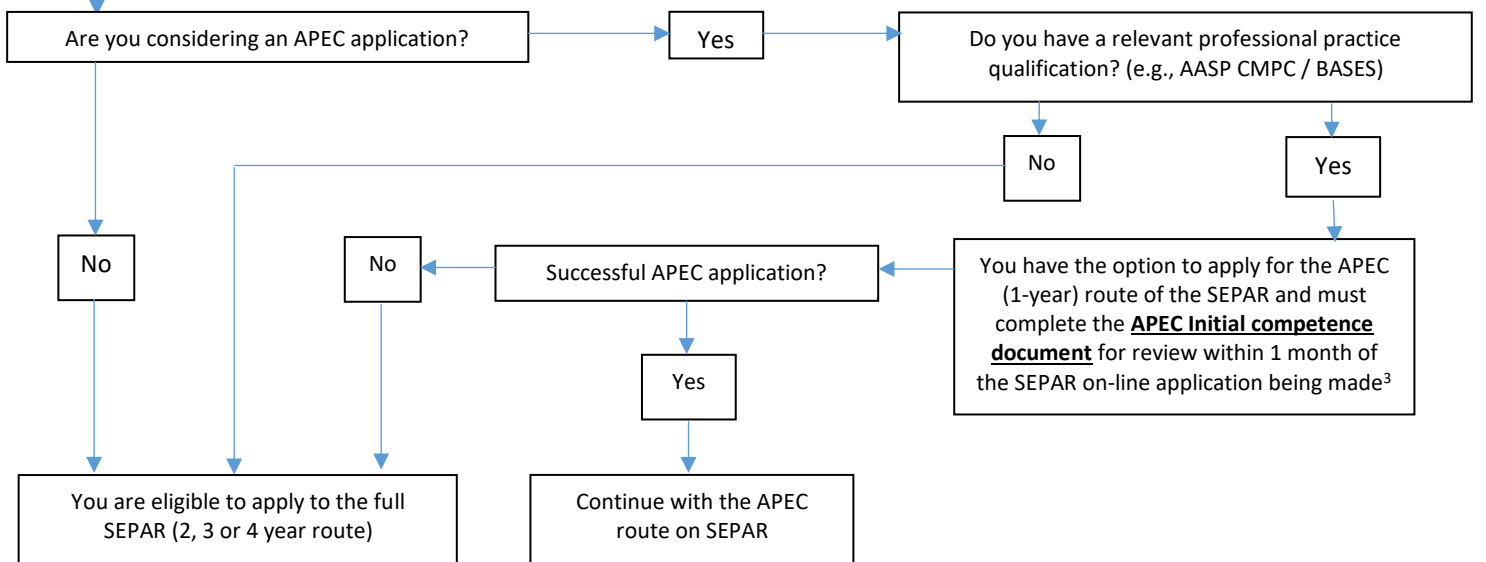
SEPAR pre-application checks. Are you:

1. A UK citizen who has lived in the UK for the last 5-years
2. A UK citizen who has spent some/all of the last 5 years living out of the UK
3. A UK citizen but currently living out of the UK
4. A non-UK citizen currently living in the UK
5. A non-UK citizen currently living out of the UK

¹ **Pre-Application Annex 1** must be completed by anyone who has completed their underpinning psychology knowledge outside of the UK. The annex will be reviewed by the course team at the Open University to map against the learning outcomes for the 'Investigating Psychology 2' module that covers all necessary underpinning psychology.

There is a cost of **£100** for the review.

² **Pre-Application Annex 2** must be completed by anyone who holds a generic MSc from a UK HE institution (e.g., Sport and Exercise Science; Sports Science (Psychology); Coaching Science), or a relevant single-discipline taught M-level (or above) Sport and Exercise Psychology qualification from an International institution. The annex will be reviewed by the SEPAR lead and the SEPAR Reviewer representatives.

There is a cost of **£100** for the review.

³ **APEC Initial competence document** must be completed by anyone wishing to apply to the APEC route of the SEPAR within **1 month** of the on-line application being completed. The APEC route is for individuals who already hold a relevant professional practice qualification and can provide clear evidence of continued supervision with a suitably qualified supervisor/s. The APEC Initial competence document will be reviewed by two SEPAR reviewers and there is no guarantee of a successful outcome. In the event of an unsuccessful APEC application, the candidate will have the opportunity to transfer to the 2, 3 or 4-year route.

The fee for the review will be taken from the registration fee that will be non-refundable.
